Tom Parker Bowles is a food writer, restaurant critic and accomplished television presenter. He has published six books on the subject of food, including three cookbooks.

Based in the UK, Tom is the restaurant critic for *The Mail on Sunday* and is also the Food Editor for *Esquire* magazine. He is also a contributing Editor for *Conde Nast Traveller* (UK) and *Departures* (US).

No stranger to Australian screens, Tom was a judge on Nine Network's *Family Food Fight* in 2017 and is excited to be reprising his role, in 2018.

Previously, Tom's been a judge on Nine's restaurant competition series *The Hot Plate* and Simon Cowell's primetime show *Food Glorious Food* for ITV UK; he's co-presented *Market Kitchen* on UKTV and been a regular contributor on Gordon Ramsey's *The F Word* on Channel 4.

A celebrated writer, Tom's books on food include *Let's Eat Meat* (2014), *Let's Eat Recipes from my Kitchen Notebook* (2012), *Full English – A Journey Through the British and their Food* (2009), *The Year of Eating Dangerously* (2006) and *E is for Eating – An Alphabet of Greed* (2004). He won plaudits for his book *Full English* at *The Guide of Food Writers Awards*, 2010 when it was awarded Best Work on British Food.

His most recent work, Fortnum and Mason -The Cook Book, was published in 2016.

Tom has two children and although based in London, is a regular visitor to Australia. He is also an ambassador for GREAT, which promotes Britain abroad.
